1.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work envisaged in this tender broadly consists of Civil, Structural, Glazing, Façade, Road and related external development Works consisting of but not limited to the following works:

- 1.1 Jungle Clearance, Removal of trees, stacking, segregating, transporting and disposing of material.
- 1.2 Earth Work in excavation, filling in all types of soils, anti-termite treatment, etc.
- 1.3 PCC and RCC works in sub-structure and super-structure including pre-cast components like cover slabs, trenches etc.
- 1.4 Blast resistant RC walls for main buildings.
- 1.5 Preparation of Bar Bending Schedule (BBS) for concrete structures as per the 'Approved for Construction' (AFC) drawings.
- 1.6 Structural steel works including structural deck slabs.
- 1.7 Roof sheeting works, expansion joint treatment, waterproofing treatment etc.
- 1.8 Brick masonry and stone masonry works in sub-structures and super-structures.
- 1.9 Finishing work like plastering, painting, stone cladding, flooring etc.
- 1.10 Façade works in terracotta tiles and louver, Façade glazing and Cladding works.
- 1.11 Submission of detailed calculations for the façade works and related supporting structure
- 1.12 Road works including footpaths.
- 1.13 Underground Sump works
- 1.14 External Storm water drainage and Sewerage works.
- 1.15 Miscellaneous works including dismantling works, site barricading works, etc.
- 1.16 Preparation of shop drawings, AS-BUILT mark-up prints on AFC Drawings and subsequent updation of the same in soft copy (AutoCAD & BIM/ RAVIT) of AFC drawings and submission of hard copy and soft copy to Engineer-in-charge as per directions.
- 1.17 Implementation of IGBC Requirements for IGBC Platinum Rating Certification.
- 1.18 Implementation of safety measures in all works undertaken by the contractor as per the provisions of the contract and best industry practices.



Any other works, not specifically mentioned herein, but required for the satisfactory and successful handover for works by other contractor as per directions of the Engineer-In-Charge shall also be in the scope of the contractor.
