

Privacy Statement

Indian Financial Technology and Allied Services is referred to as “IFTAS”, "we", or “our”.

This document informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information when you use our www.iftas.in. This Privacy Policy does not apply to any of our websites, products or services that have a separate privacy policy.

Information Collection

We automatically log some basic information and ask for the least amount of personal information, what we believe is essential for doing business.

When you visit our websites, we automatically collect information that web browsers, mobile devices and servers make available, such as the internet protocol address, browser type, language preference, time zone, referring URL, date and time of access, operating system, mobile device manufacturer and mobile network information. We include these in our log files. We use this information to improve our websites and also to detect and prevent illegal activities.

We may record and analyze your interactions with us, including email, telephone, and chat conversations with our sales and customer support professionals. This record may include your personal information, i.e. Name, Email address, Contact number, Company name and designation. We use this information to communicate with you.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that can be used by websites to make a user's experience more efficient.

IFTAS does not use any cookies to store any personal information pertaining to the website user.

Mailers

IFTAS does not offer any newsletter service that visitors can opt-in or opt-out of. Therefore the company does not have any intention to send mailers to the users of the www.iftas.in. However IFTAS may contact you if you have filled up any form requesting information or would like to conduct business with us.

Anti-Spam

We recognize that the receipt, transmission or distribution of spam emails (unsolicited bulk emails) is a major concern for individual and corporate alike. Therefore IFTAS has taken reasonable measures, to minimize the transmission and effect of spam emails in its computing environment. Any email identified as spam will be rejected.
